

Target/Trap Shoot (Post Decal/Pass Needed)

Visitors who do not have a decal to enter Ft. Knox will need to go to the visitor's center on Bullion Blvd. to get a pass. You will be asked to present the following information.

If you have a retired service identification (Id) card you can go to the visitor's center and present your Id card, along with proof of vehicle insurance, vehicle registration and a valid driver's license or driver's license for the person who drives for you. You will get a post decal that is good for up to 4 years.

Veterans who do not have a military Id or retired service ID card can present their V.A. card, along with proof of vehicle insurance, vehicle registration and a valid driver's license or driver's license for the person who drives for you. You will get a pass that is good for one year. Remember to only place that pass out while visiting Ft. Knox.

Non veterans will be required to go to the visitor's center with proof of vehicle insurance, vehicle registration, and a valid driver's license to get a one day pass.

If any member has trouble getting into the visitor center they can call 502-624-7177, this number will allow any member to get the manager on duty at the visitor center.

To get to the visitor center on Bullion Blvd. either take 31W South out of Louisville or 31W North and you will clearly see the sign to exit to Bullion Blvd. After getting your pass at the visitor center continue on Bullion Blvd. then turn right onto Eisenhower. Continue on Eisenhower then turn left onto Wilson Rd. Travel on Wilson Rd. about half a mile then turn right onto Pickett Rd. Travel on Pickett Rd. about a mile then turn right onto Upton Rd. After coming to a yield sign you will see the French Range across from Main Range Rd.

Or you can take a left at the 1st traffic signal on Eisenhower onto Brandenburg Station Rd. Travel about 1-2 miles on Brandenburg Station Rd. then turn right onto Frazier Rd. Travel on Frazier Rd. until you come to a four way stop. Cross over and you will be on Main Range Road, take that until you see the French Range on the left side of the street. It will be the 3rd range on that road after crossing the 4 way stop.
